Symphony Solutions Donated Profits and Raised Almost 1 MLN EUR for Ukraine

In the year 2022, the normal way of life was disrupted in ways that we couldn't have predicted. As early as the end of February, the lives of many people were uprooted and distorted when Ukraine was attacked by russia. Our charity initiatives were one way to try and bring back some sense of normal into daily life.

Symphony Solutions has its largest delivery center in Lviv, Ukraine, which made the urgent and personal. Since the first day of the war, we are supporting the country and its people. Theo Schnitfink, Founder and CEO of Symphony Solutions, made the decision to donate company profits generated in Ukraine back to where it was needed most. Moreover, we launched numerous charity initiatives and overall raised almost one million euros in support of Ukraine.

Symphony Solutions remained true to our values and found new ways to give back to the community, initiate and support charity projects concerning the most immediate needs of Ukrainians affected by the war, and plan and invest in a peaceful future. All of this is reflected in our Social Corporate Responsibility Program – Symphony Care.

How we care? War crisis Immediate response

The year 2022 brought about unforeseeable challenges as Ukraine faced immediate danger from the aggressor. We have faced a lot of uncertainty, anxiety, and growing social concern. Symphony Solutions immediately responded to the war crisis and in mere weeks launched the Stand by Ukraine charity foundation dedicated to raising funds and providing humanitarian and emergency aid to Ukraine.

STAND BY UKRAINE

"Stand by Ukraine" charity foundation was created in the first weeks of war with the aim to raise funds and provide humanitarian and emergency aid to Ukraine. The foundation is purchasing medication, equipment, and all other necessary humanitarian goods to provide support to Ukrainian people. https://standby-ukraine.com/

What was purchased:

- Humanitarian sets (food and hygiene products) delivered to the most vulnerable groups of people in Kharkiv
- Essential medical and protective gear:
 - Protective clothing
 - Rehabilitation equipment
 - Ambulances
- Supporting shelters.

We have already raised almost 1 000 000 EUR.

OFFICES TURNED SHELTERS

After the war started in Ukraine, we turned Symphony Solutions offices into shelters to take in Symphonians, their family and friends.

Offices in Lviv, Krakow, and Rzeszow were equipped with all the necessities to provide a comfortable place to stay for a few days or longer. The conditions included beds, a shower, and a kitchen. Personally supervised by Theo Shnitfink, shelter coordinators and volunteers worked on making the place more comfortable for the people coming here.

The office shelters have welcomed over 200 people. Refugees were also assisted with finding permanent apartments or further relocation.





SUPPORTING UNBROKEN REHABILITATION CENTER IN LVIV, UKRAINE

National Rehabilitation Center Unbroken was created with the goal to provide medical care and rehabilitation services to civilians and military personnel wounded in the war in Ukraine. The center provides reconstructive surgery, prosthesis care, psychological, and social rehabilitation.

We have donated over 100,000 euros to the rehabilitation center which is used to purchase equipment for diagnostic and rehabilitation purposes.

Furthermore, we have purchased two bionic hand prostheses created by Epser Bionics for wounded soldiers. The prostheses have already been delivered to the hospital and successfully installed.



DATTALION

Dattalion, or "data battalion", has been created by Ukrainian women as an immediate response to the war in Ukraine. Established on February 27, 2022, the initiative has launched a mass database of photo and video footage that documents the war atrocities of Russia on the frontlines and temporarily occupied territories of Ukraine.

Dattalion objectives:

- Empower media around the world to tell the truth
- Collect and store evidence of war crimes, environmental crimes, crimes against humanity, and acts
 of genocide
- Amplify to the world the vital need to stand with Ukraine to win the war

Team of 7 Symphonians provides its full ongoing development and marketing support to the Dattalion project for 6 months.

SUPPORTING SYMPHONIANS IN THE ARMY

As we understand the gravity of "feeding your own army", we have initiated many activities to support Ukraine's fight for peace and in particular those Symphonians who came to the brave decision to put down their laptops and join the army.

- Symphony Security Package provided to every drafted Symphonian, which includes safety equipment, a first aid kit, and other specialized items as requested
- Unity Fund launched as an initiative by Symphonians for Symphonians who are joining the army
- Fundraising organized by Symphonians to support friends and colleagues in the army
- Charity auction in the Lviv office with all proceeds going to army needs

REBUILDUA PROJECT WITH COVIZMO

We joined the RebuildUA project initiated by our client Covizmo as a way to start contributing to Ukraine's future right now.

The purpose of the project RebuildUA is recording wartime damages by creating a reliable data foundation of satellite imaging and information regarding civil infrastructure and prepare for the reconstruction of Ukraine once the peace is restored.

The project makes it possible to provide reliable data reports and share the results with communities, public authorities, and specialized foundations. It will help collect and verify data on the destructions of war, assess damages, and understand what further steps to take in rebuilding Ukraine.



SUPPORTING DOCTORS WITHOUT BORDERS



Symphony Solutions' Lviv office was honored to host the team of the international medical humanitarian organization Médecins Sans Frontières / Doctors Without Borders.

The volunteers of the organization are helping people around the world who suffer the consequences of conflict, pandemics, or natural disasters. These professional healthcare workers, logistics, and administrative staff came to Ukraine to provide their support and professional help to the people of Ukraine.

We provided the volunteers of Doctors Without Borders with a comfortable place to stay and office space that they could use for work while performing their noble mission of helping Ukrainians afflicted by war.
